

# Welcome UC Santa Barbara!

For UC Santa Barbara students, ieiMedia is offering a 3-week version of its standard Jerusalem Program which is described on the website page for [The Jerusalem Project](#). UC Santa Barbara students are required to complete a preparatory pre-trip course segment in Santa Barbara during the spring quarter with Jerusalem Project instructor Nomi Morris, who directs the UC Santa Barbara Journalism Certificate Program. UC Santa Barbara students will receive 4 credits.

**DATES:** June 28<sup>th</sup> – July 19<sup>th</sup> 2020.

**PROGRAM COST:** \$4,495 + airfare (Includes: Tuition – 4 credits, housing, instruction, health insurance, farewell dinner and special programs, activities and cultural events).

## UC Santa Barbara Program Highlights

**Program Costs:** The standard program tuition is reduced by \$500 to bring the cost to \$4,495. American citizens are entitled to \$750 scholarships available through the Rothberg International Schools Office of Academic Affairs which reduces the tuition to **\$3,745**. - Additional needs-based scholarship funding is available through the American Friends of Hebrew University.
- [The Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship Program](#) offers grants for U.S. citizen undergraduate students of limited financial means to pursue academic studies abroad. The amount awarded can potentially **wipe all remaining tuition costs!** The application must be submitted by **Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019** and there are several steps to complete. **Duration:** This is a **3-week program** from **June 28<sup>th</sup> – July 19<sup>th</sup> 2020**, with a syllabus adapted from ieiMedia's 4-week program (June 28 - July 26, 2020).

**Credits:** An additional credit will be added for the UC Santa Barbara program to bring the total to **4 credits**. Students must participate in a pre-trip course segment with UCSB Writing Program Lecturer Nomi Morris at the university during the spring quarter.
